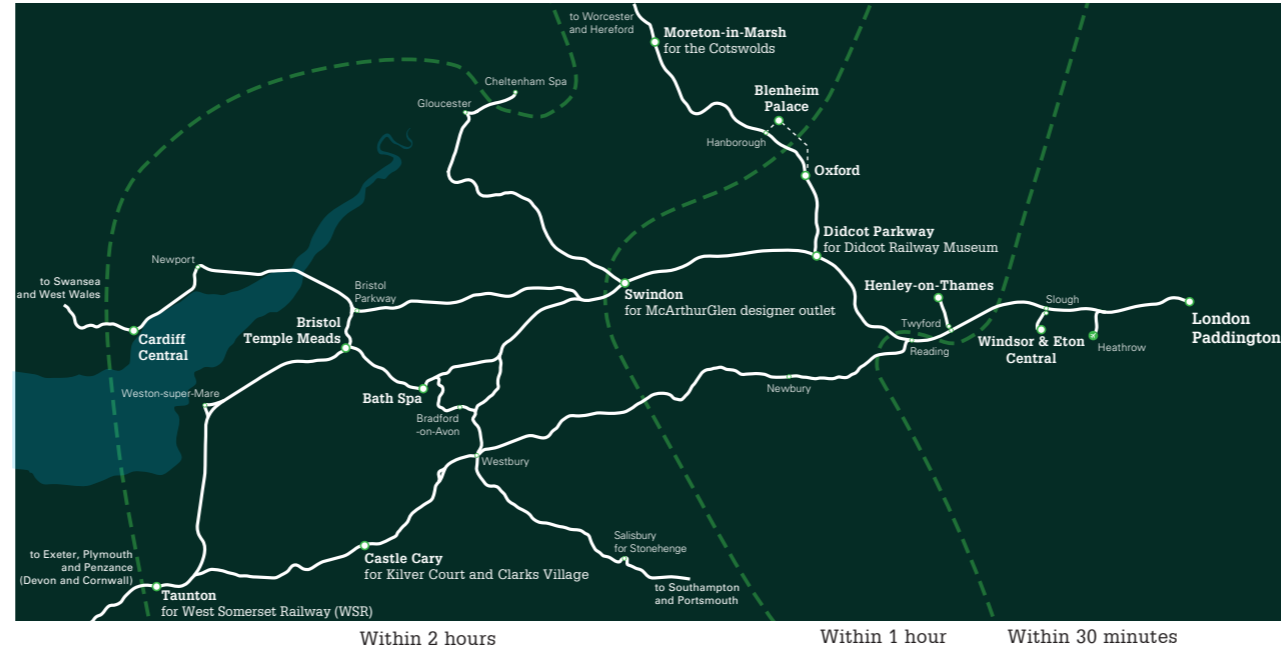

## Map of GWR destinations

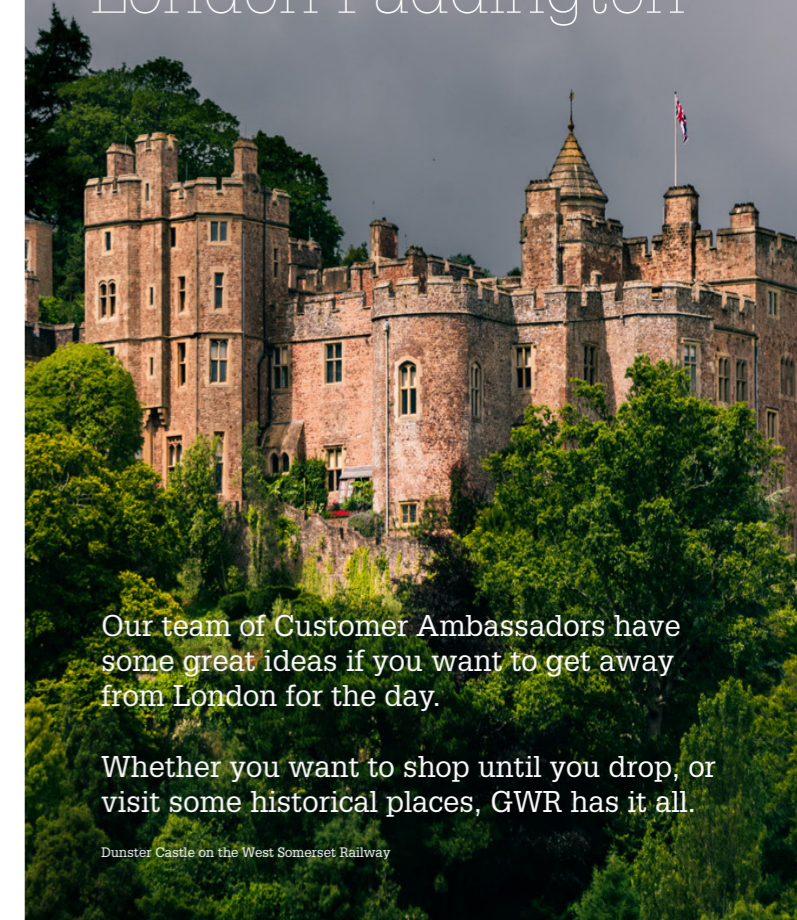

## Within 1 hour of London Paddington

### Windsor **£**

Windsor Castle has been the family home of British kings and queens for almost 1,000 years. When Her Majesty The Queen is there, her flag is flown from the Round Tower.

It's easy to get to Windsor by changing trains at Slough, and the Castle is just a short walk from the station.

The world-famous University of Oxford boasts architecture that makes the city popular with visitors from around the globe.

Enjoy a picnic in the Oxford Botanic Garden, or take a guided tour of Oxford Castle.

## Under 2 hours of London Paddington

### Blenheim Palace **££**

Blenheim Palace is the birthplace of Sir Winston Churchill, and home to one of the most impressive collections of paintings in Europe.

If you buy a GWR Blenheim Palace ticket, it includes train travel to Oxford station, a No.500 or S3 bus to Blenheim, and entry to the palace and grounds.

Step back in time to the age of steam with The West Somerset Railway, the longest heritage line in the country. Visit the seaside town of Minehead or the ancient town of Dunster.
